

Continuing Education Units (CEU) Information

NHSA is committed to helping individuals advance their knowledge and skills by providing learning opportunities that are enriching and valuable. The International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET) recognizes NHSA professional development and training programs as high quality and designates it as an authorized provider of IACET CEUs.

NHSA adheres to IACET criteria and awards one CEU per 10 instructional contact hours. In all cases, the number of CEUs awarded will be based on the total number of instructional contact hours divided by “10.” Conference attendees can earn CEUs by registering for CEUs and following the established procedural guidelines. To be awarded CEUs participants must:

- a. Attend at least 95 percent of a session and be present for the critical content.
- b. Participate in any assessment of knowledge, including the session’s “question and answer” period.
- c. Submit all sessions attended, dates, and times via the Continuing Education Unit Attendance/Assessment Form.
- d. Obtain the instructor’s/presenter’s signature at the end of each session.
- e. Complete a CEU Attendee Evaluation Form for each session listed on the CEU Attendance/Assessment Form.
