Continuing Education Training **Intellectual Property Rights Policy**

Any materials, publications, processes, or related works for the design and delivery of continuing education and training developed by the presenter without the assistance of NHSA, shall be owned by the presenter in accordance with US and International Copyright laws (hereinafter the "Work"). The presenter shall provide NHSA with a non-exclusive license for the Work under reasonable terms as to use, distribution and royalties.

The presenter shall grant NHSA a perpetual license to: (1) copy, reproduce, publish and distribute the Work in all print and other formats (including but not limited to online publication via NHSA's Web site, and distribution at future NHSA programs and conferences); (2) reprint the Work for distribution; and (3) make the Work available for purchase and distribution after a continuing education and training event.

In granting a consent license and release, the presenter acknowledges and agrees that NHSA shall be under no obligation to pay for delivery of any service performed in presenting continuing education and training session at an NHSA conference or event, or for the permission/license granted to NHSA to reproduce, publish and distribute the Work.

The presenter shall further represent and warrant that except as noted below: (1) they are the author and owner of the Work and all rights in and to all portions of the Work; (2) the Work is original; (3) the Work does not violate or infringe on any personal or property rights of others, whether common law or statutory; (4) the Work contains nothing libelous or otherwise contrary to law; and (5) they are authorized and empowered to grant the license and release to NHSA.

The presenter agrees to indemnify and hold harmless NHSA, its officers, directors, employees and volunteers from any and all claims of copyright infringement made against NHSA and arising out of the Work and the presentation of the Work. The presenter must further represent and warrant that if the Work contains material from other works protected by copyright that such other works have been used with the written consent of the copyright owner and that the presenter has provided (or are simultaneously providing) NHSA with copies of all such required written author consents.

NHSA agrees to provide presenters with appropriate authorship credit and acknowledgment each time it publishes or republishes the Work, and to require authorized sub-licensees if any, to also provide appropriate authorship credit and acknowledgments. NHSA understands and agrees that any grant of rights does not constitute a transfer of copyright and that the presenter remains free to present the Work or revised versions elsewhere.
